The Université du Québec à Montréal is seeking qualified candidates to renew its faculty and ensure quality development in all areas of its activity.

The School of Visual and Media Arts is seeking an artist or educator with a recognized practice, whose work demonstrates critical reflection and a mastery of the theoretical and historical issues of contemporary art.

The ideal candidate has a broad knowledge of various contemporary approaches to visual and media arts. Their practice demonstrates critical reflection on current issues in art.

The successful candidate will be called upon to intervene in the teaching of core disciplines in visual and media arts, according to the specificity of their practice. They will be expected to demonstrate an ability to generate connections with practices taught in the School of Visual and Media Arts.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's degree in visual and media arts or a related discipline
- Minimum of six (6) years of relevant professional experience and a proven expertise that is recognized by the artistic community in the field of art or in a related field
- Sustained artistic production and dissemination in recognized national and international contemporary art networks
- Ability to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels
- Ability to implement research projects
- Ability to work in a team and to develop new programs of study or new orientations
- Mastery of the French language, both oral and written

- A detailed, dated and hand-signed resume in French
- A cover letter outlining the candidate's practice, intention to contribute to the school's research and creation areas, teaching experience, and ability to teach courses in our programs. The letter should indicate the intended hiring period; 2023-2024, 2024-2025 or both (maximum: 1000 words)
- A portfolio documenting the record of professional practice, research, and creation, with a descriptive list of visual materials
- The names and contact information of three references
